A Report Concerning the Nassau County Democratic Committee Convention - May 27, 2014

The Rockville Centre Democratic Club is an independent, not for profit corporation of the State of New York. It regularly reports on activities of the Town, County, State and National Democratic Committees. The Club is not a member of any of those committees and does not fall within the organizational structure or direction of any of those committees. This report is NOT made by or in behalf of any of those committees.

Later in this report, there is the list of candidates for public office nominated at the Dem convention last night (May 27). Also nominated were people for party positions at the State, County and Town levels. The party positions are not included on the list below. (A video of the proceedings will be posted in the near future.).

Substantially less than a majority of the Committee people of the RVC Zone appeared to be actually present. Most of those were present and past members of the RVC-Dems Board of Directors. An unknown additional number gave proxies.

The body was not given the opportunity to vote on the candidates for Congress. **There will be a primary on June 24, 2014. The primary contest will be between Kathleen Rice and Kevan Abrahams.**

The general election will be on November 4, 2014.

We have included maps of the 4th CD, the 21st AD and the 9th SD, at this end of this email.

There was no resolution or discussion of issues relating to the present or future of Nassau County or relating to the logistics of the coming political campaign. The only resolution presented was one that gave power to the County Committee Chairperson and the County Executive Committee to fill empty candidate slots with whomever they wished, including non-Democrats.

The nominated candidates were not visually presented to the Convention and there were no acceptance speeches.

Happily, Chairman Jay Jacobs' prior differences have been resolved with Dave Denenberg, candidate for State Senate (8th SD), have been resolved and the Chairman was effusive in his now full support for Dave.

The entire convention, which started about a half hour late, lasted about 26 minutes, including the Pledge of Allegiance. It was followed by a longer

mini convention of the 20th AD.

There was no mention of the number of Committee members required to constitute a quorum or the number of actual and "weighted" Committee members who were present at the Convention. Chairs were set out for 312 people, and most of them had Committee members or observers sitting in them. There were no badges, so it was not possible to tell the difference.

No printed material was handed out by the County Committee.

Pizza was served, that appeared to have survived, as well as could be expected, from last year's convention.

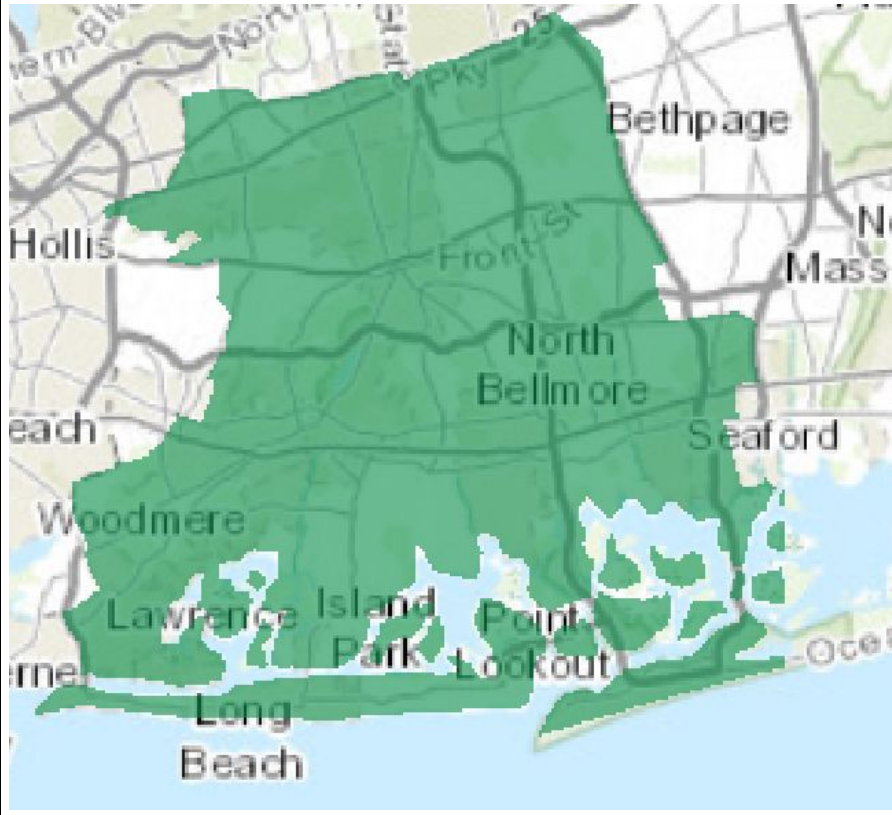

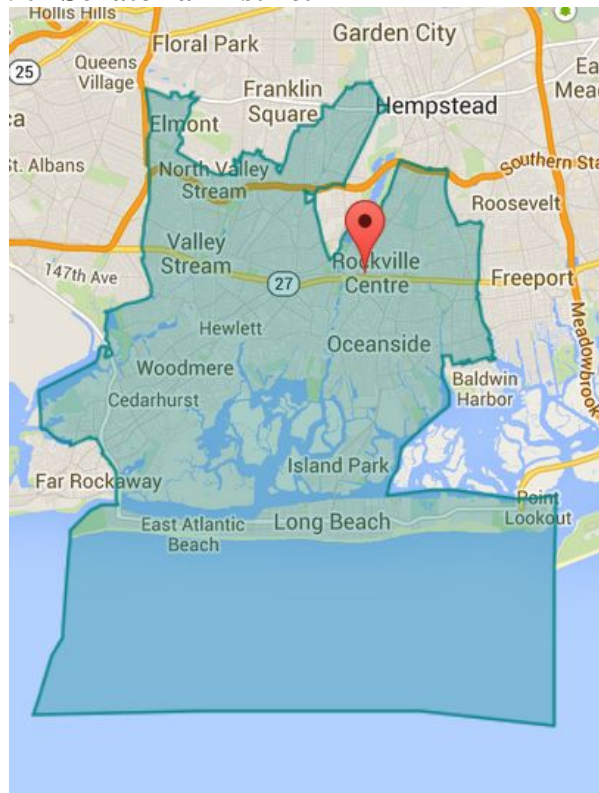
